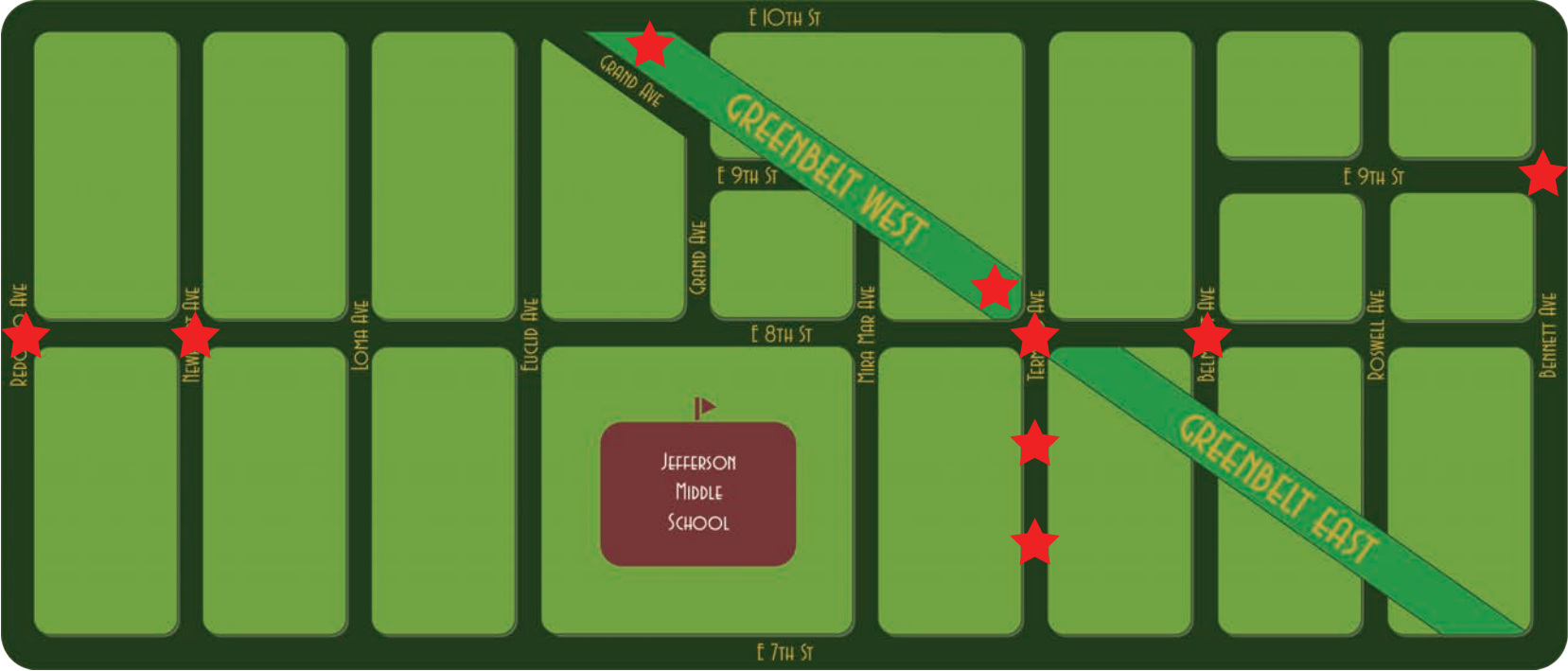


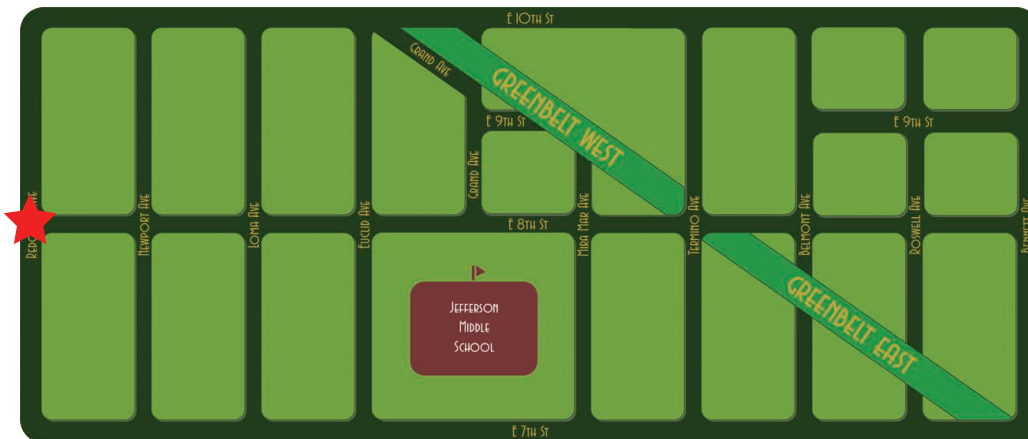
Greenbelt Heights Neighborhood Improvements Proposal

Proposal:

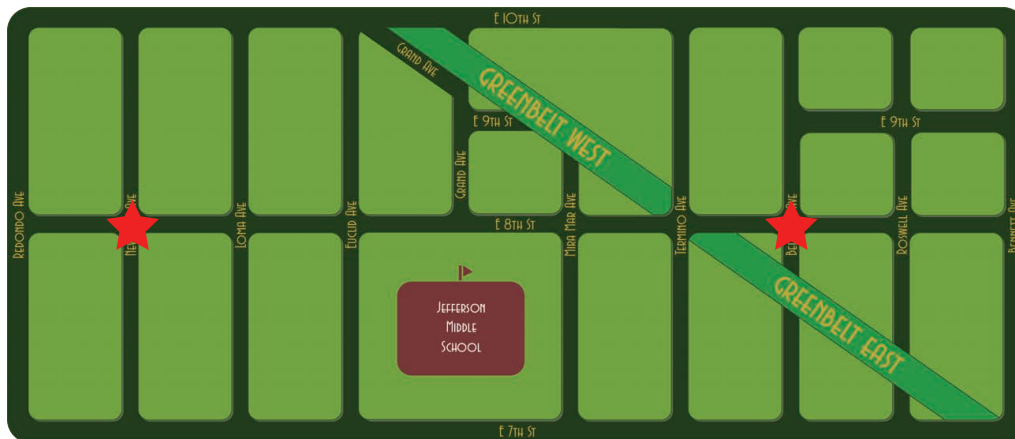
This intersection is part of the corridor from Rose Park to both Jefferson Leadership Academies and Wilson High School. To protect children while crossing, we propose adding a designated crosswalk with a pedestrian-activated stoplight.

8th & Newport

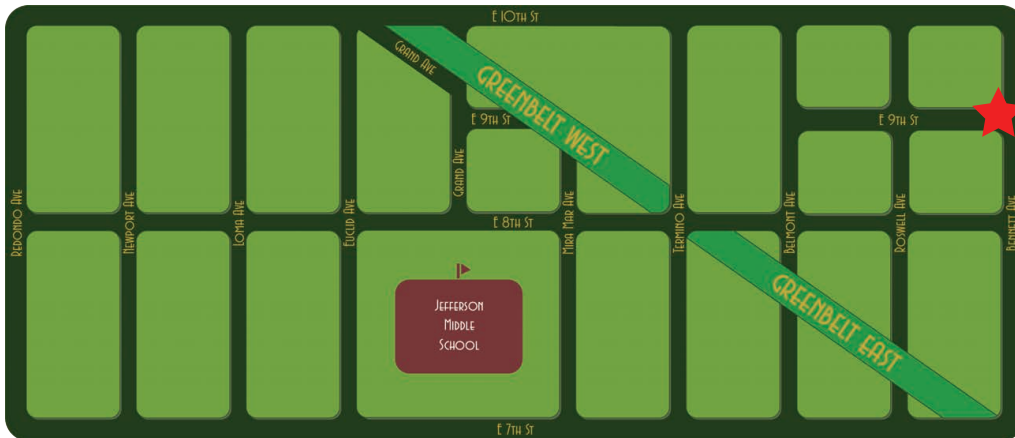
8th & Belmont



Proposal:

E 8th St is a pedestrian corridor for students of both Jefferson Leadership Academies and Wilson High School. Two intersections (8th & Newport and 8th & Belmont) have no ADA ramps, so we propose that they are added for ADA compliance.

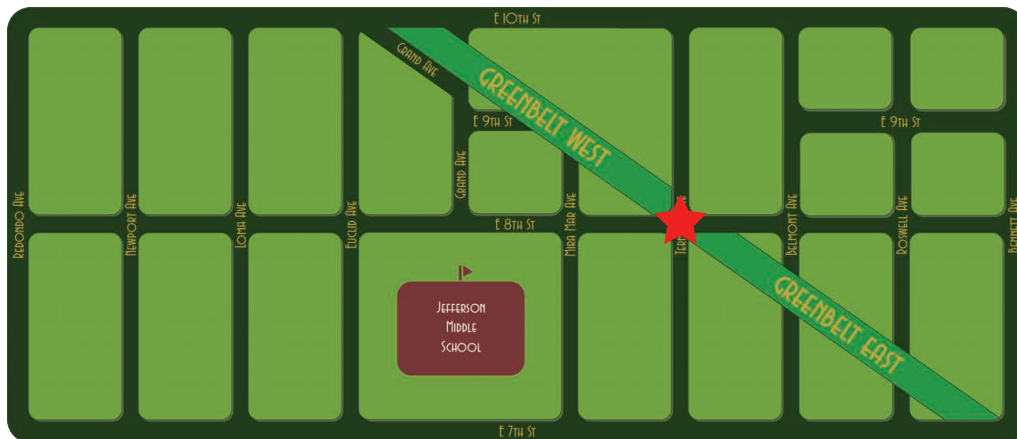
Make Bennett St ADA Compliant



Proposal:

Bennett St is a pedestrian corridor for students of both Jefferson Leadership Academies and Wilson High School. One intersection (9th & Bennett) have no ADA ramps, so we propose that they are added for ADA compliance.

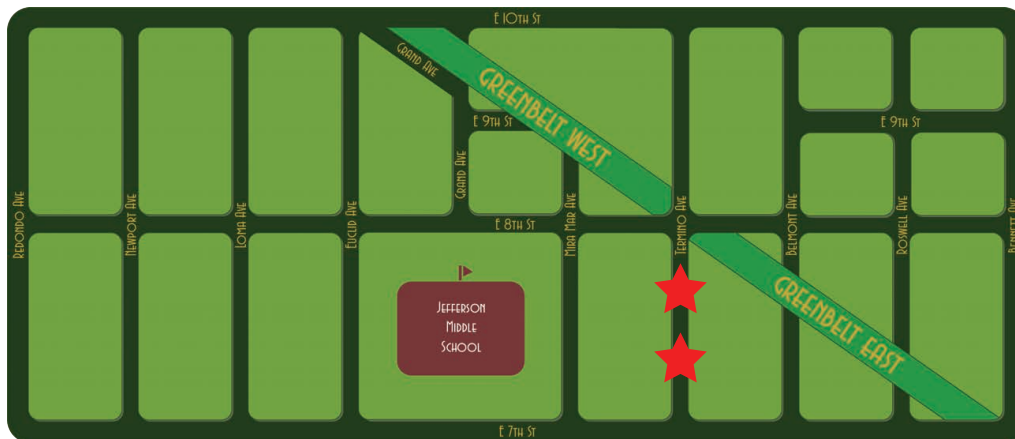
Add 4th Crosswalk at Intersection of E 8th St and Termino Ave



Proposal:

This intersection is a pedestrian corridor traveled by students at both Jefferson Leadership Academies and Wilson High School, as well as by people on their way to the recently reopened Greenbelt. It is missing one section of crosswalk, so we propose for pedestrian safety that it be added.

Resurface/Repave Termino Ave between E 7th and E 8th Streets



Proposal:

This section of Termino Ave is the worst-kept road in the neighborhood; it's a patchwork of cracked concrete and asphalt-filled potholes. As the most-traveled street in the neighborhood, we propose that the road be resurfaced/repaved.

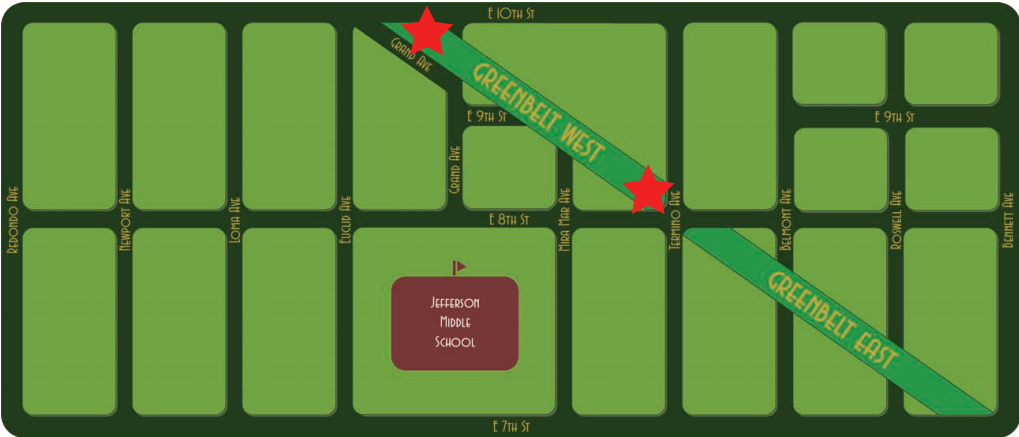
Add City-Maintained Dog Waste Bags and Recepticals in "Greenbelt West"

Proposal:

The entrances to "Greenbelt West" (the section of the Greenbelt between E 8th and E 10th Streets) often have mounds of dog waste bags piled near the fence. We propose the City adds and maintains dog waste bag dispensers and trash cans at both the 8th St and 10th St entrances of "Greenbelt West", much like the ones in neighboring "Greenbelt East" (the section of the Greenbelt between E 8th and E 7th Streets).

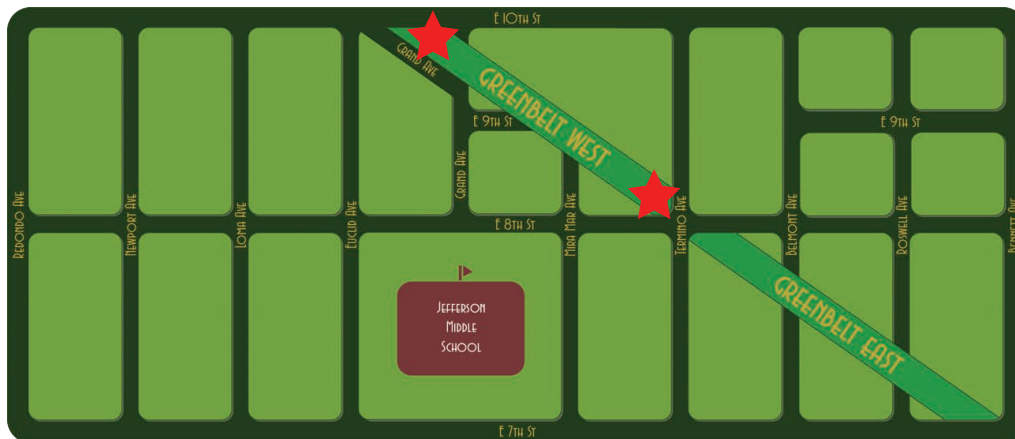
Bring Down Fences and Add City Ordinances at Entrances of “Greenbelt West”

The entrances to “Greenbelt West” have high fences that make it uninviting for neighbors to use such valuable public space.
